Dear Parent/Carer

Creating the right atmosphere for a consistently good learning environment is a priority. In order to achieve this our expectations have been shared with all students through assemblies.

1. Mobiles

Mobile phones have become an unnecessary distraction during lessons. From today mobile phones are no longer permitted to be on or used during lesson time. If a mobile phone is seen or is heard ringing or alerting for messages during lesson time, the phone will be confiscated. The phone will be then handed to the Headteacher's Secretary where parents/carers will be required to sign and collect the phone. If a student refuses to hand over the phone there will be an additional consequence.

2. Jewellery

Since returning after the Easter break it has also been observed that a number of pupils have been openly wearing facial piercings.

In accordance with the school's policy on student dress code, I would like to remind you that all facial piercings including tongue piercings are not permitted.

From the start of Term 6, Monday 1st June 2015, if a student attends the school with a facial piercing and then refuses to remove it, parents and carers will be contacted in order to reinforce our expectations.

3. Be on time and ready to learn

All students are expected to be in school for 8:50am to commence their day. They will also need to be equipped with an appropriate school bag (one which can carry an A4 folder), a pen, pencil and a ruler. This will be an expectation from Tuesday 5th May 2015.
