Student Dress Code

Pent Valley has a school dress code for Years 7 to 11 and post 16 which must be adhered to by all. In post 16, the dress code is smart and formal. Its purpose is to encourage a sense of belonging to our community at Pent Valley.

The compulsory dress code for Years 7 to 11 consists of:

A Navy blue blazer with school logo.

Grey trousers or skirt.

A white formal shirt/blouse with collar.

A school tie.

Plain black formal shoes with dark socks / tights or white socks.

Students have the option of also wearing a school jumper (but not as a replacement for the blazer).

A plain Navy or black coat.

The school blazer and tie must be purchased from our suppliers Price & Buckland.

No jewellery: only watches are permitted.

Nail varnish: is not to be worn in years 7-11.

Make up: is not permitted in years 7-8. This may be discreet in years 9-11.

No visible tattoos.

Hair: should be sensible and not extreme in any way.

The PE kit comprises plain navy blue shorts or tracksuit bottoms combined with a white t-shirt with school logo.

Other items of PE kit required are as follows:

- Training shoes
- Plain black, navy or white socks (change from school wear)
- Boots for rugby and football
- Shin pads for football and hockey
- Navy football socks

A towel will be required for showers.

For students in years 9 to 11 they have the option of continuing to wear their existing PE kit until it needs replacing.
